PM Cloud

New Features and Enhancements:

Policy Editor

- Added capability so Administrators can now create, edit, and manage Windows Custom Tokens by configuring integrity level, group membership, privileges, and process access rights.
- Added truncation, tooltips, and more compact data grids to show more results, made more use of available page real estate, and improved the user experience.
- Added drill down capability from Windows and Mac Application Rule Summary so users can click directly to an associated Application Group.
- Increased the size of all application matcher criteria input fields and introduced tooltips to improve the user experience of adding and editing Windows and Mac application matching criteria.

PM Cloud

- Added an **Events** tab and grid to the **Application Details** page to give the user quick access to the exact events that have taken place for that one specified application.
- Enhanced usability of the existing optional filters which use *search-as-you-type* to narrow down the filter data set options within Analytics v2. Commandline, Executable Path, User Reason, and File Path have been converted to text box filters (instead of a drop down with single selection) and require a minimum of 5 characters to narrow down the dataset for these filters.
- Added the ability to create management rules to archive and delete computers. Updated the computers list to support archiving and deletion.

- Removed the PM Cloud MMC snap-in installation configuration from PM Cloud. The MMC snap-in is being sunset in favor of the web-based Policy Editor.
- Improved the performance of the computers and policies APIs.
- Extended the **Applications** grid hyperlink for **Processes** which navigate the user to the **Application Details > Events** tab.
- Implemented a change to sort the default and optional filters (and their dataset options) alphanumerically in Analytics v2.
- Added the annotation notes to the **Changes** tab for policy revision audits.

Issues Resolved:

Policy Editor

- Fixed an issue where Chinese characters entered as a comment on **Save & Unlock** were not displaying correctly in the **Revisions** comment field in PM Cloud.
- Fixed the confirmation toast message so it is now in readable text when multiple applications are added to policy via the add to policy function in Analytics.
- Fixed issue so the *Failed* toast message no longer displays when a policy XML is successfully uploaded via the **Import Policy** window.
- Fixed an issue by updating the default for **Log Application Activity to Log Files** to **Off** on create of a new Windows Workstyle to help prevent a large number of events being produced inadvertently on local machines.

Privilege Management Reporting

- Fixed an issue so it is now possible to export *Admin Logon* events via CSV on **Privileged Logons** in Analytics.

Privilege Management Cloud

- Resolved an issue with a Saved View loading and not retaining chosen columns and widths for the view in Analytics v2.
- Resolved an issue where certain events were unnecessarily being forwarded to SIEM.
- Enhanced consistency to display a count of one version of an application on the **Applications** grid in Analytics v2.
- Resolved an issue with **Clear Filters** not resetting filters to the default values in Analytics v2.
