

Privileged Identity – ECM Plugin 18.1.2.4 Release Notes

New Features and Enhancements:

This release of the plugin for integration with Privileged Identity includes new features and enhancements both for the new release of Privileged Identity (5.5.3.1) as well as for previous releases.

- Added a configuration item to support the lookup of credentials by IP address rather than hostname. This allows customers to find and inject credentials for endpoints, even if systems are managed not by DNS and hostnames but rather IP addresses. This applies only to Jump Client items. If for some reason the public and private IP addresses are unavailable to the ECM at the time credentials are requested, the integration falls back to the default behavior of performing lookup by hostname.
- Added a configuration item to support the inclusion of domain credentials when a user connects to a Web Jump item. This allows users to inject their domain credentials (or others available to them) into many sites, internal or otherwise, that support them. Credentials are injected in the format of username@DOMAIN.
- Added a configuration item to support the new Store Credential spin job API added in Privileged Identity 5.5.3.1. This new API streamlines the auto-spin behavior by eliminating the need to create and configure template jobs and the need for the integration to manually submit new spin jobs based on those templates. The integration can now simply provide the details of the credential to spin, and Privileged Identity handles the rest internally, mirroring the same behavior that occurs when a user checks in a Store Credential via the Privileged Identity web interface. Admins can select their Privileged Identity version in the plugin configuration. This dictates which API calls are made and maintains backward compatibility for Privileged Identity releases prior to 5.5.3.1.

Notes:

- **RED IM has been renamed to Privileged Identity.**
- The Privileged Identity – ECM Plugin is compatible with:
 - Remote Support 18.1.2 and 17.1.5
 - Privileged Access 18.1.2 and 17.1.9
- Requires Endpoint Credential Manager 1.2.0.1071 or higher.
