New Features and Enhancements:

- Presentation Scheduling Enhancement Enabled the customer to run a non-English language from the rep client.
 From the presentation scheduling dialog, the customer can now access the calendar control and select a start date for the presentation. The calendar uses weekday names and month names which are translated into the appropriate language choice
- User Interface Improvements
 - o Enhanced the session notes appearance in the Session Summary Tab
 - o Resolved Fullscreen viewer issue where WindowsKey, Alt-Tab, and Alt-Esc were being transmitted when viewer's status is View-Only or Not Active
- Logging and Reporting Enhancements
 - o Added API field with URL link to access chat transcript from API reporting XML
- Language Support
